

FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions

Q: When and where are the meetings held?

A: PTC meetings are held on the 2nd Monday of each month at 7pm in the school cafeteria. If the 2nd Monday falls on a holiday, the meeting will be held the next day. Q. Can I bring my children?
